## SH Resident is World Cycling Champ

Congratulations to Sleepy Hollow resident Lorraine Jarvis. She won the women's age 50-54 500-meter time trial at the recent Track Cycling Masters World Championships in Sydney, Australia, and she has the gold medal and world champ jersey to prove it.

Her winning time of 39.427 seconds was more than a half-second ahead of her nearest rival – and only four women over age 50 have ever broken 40 seconds for 500-meters! It took eight months of training to prepare for just 40 seconds of racing.

Lorraine won the very first track race she ever entered in the 2003 California State Championships at Hellyer, and since then, she's accumulated some 26 state champ medals, one individual, and two team titles at the U.S. nationals in '08, thanks in large part to the advice and support of her husband/coach Kelly Silberberg.

Additional Board activities include the formation of a Pool Committee. This Committee includes members from the SHHA Board, Swim Team Board and a few Members at Large. Our pool is facing some major repairs this year, and will require some on-going repairs to ensure this valuable asset is properly maintained.

The Board has also created a petition around our frustration with the fence that James Hetfield put across the fire road along the Luiz Ranch Fire Road. We're hoping to gain 500 signatures. ## Closed Trail Update

If you've ever hiked, biked, or gone horseback riding along the ridge dividing Sleepy Hollow from Terra Linda heading Northwest, you've probably encountered an oversized metal fence blocking your path. James Hetfield, property owner and ex-band member of the group Metallica, decided that he no longer wished to give the public access to the trail that passed through his property.

The Marin County Open Space District has developed a plan for a bypass trail. Currently called "680 Trail," it will restore the critical 3-mile connection between the Terra Linda/Sleepy Hollow and Loma Alta Open Space Preserves. To learn more, there are 2 scheduled meetings

on Wed. Jan. 27<sup>th</sup> and then again on Sat., Jan. 30<sup>th</sup> as follows:

- 9am-10am: A presentation in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Marin Co., Civic Center, 3501 Civic Center Dr., San Rafael
- 11:30-4pm: Hike of proposed trail route. To join, meet at 11:30am at the top of the Luiz Ranch Fire Road. It is a strenuous hike and participants must be able to walk from the paved road to a meeting location and then hike from that point for several hours in steep and unimproved terrain.
