## Noteworthy Trees in Sleepy Hollow

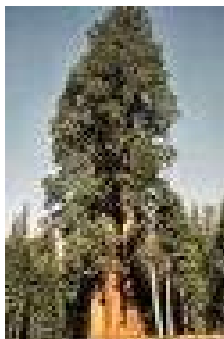
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What are some of the interesting trees in the Hollow? Let's work together on this. Tell me about a tree that is of special interest.
