BUBBA DOES SNAP PEAS

Well, Bubba Butterfield got 'one of those.' So, while known for his palatial palate, it's now "Bubba lite". Meaning, rabbit food. Still, some pretty darn good eatin, if ya find the spice shelf and a few cool restaurants that actually have, "healthy" salads *without* cheese. As Bubba learned, harder to find than you think.

Bubba pairs these dining out options with some samplings of his recent greenery concoctions on the home front. Use small plates, in "rainbow" display. Garnish with San Pelli-grino.

Osteria Stellina, Point Reyes. Bubba believed formerly that this establishment was a sacrilegious and pretentious attack on the down-home Station House Grill, a place solely catering to SF-ites wearing black cycling shorts, and weekend warrioring. Well, Bubba no longer cares, and they have some great small dishes, like Cannelloni beans and greens. Try it, Mikey, and you will like it. Mushroom soup with chervil, oyster pizza, braised goat with polenta! Roasted Asparagus with lemon aoli, Slow cooked octopus

with mint! Beef cheeks with rosemary potatoes! Most of this Bubba avoids, but goes for the greens, which all are grown in Marin. Grab some mutton or duck chorizo on the way out of town at Sun Farms Butcher Shop, too.

The home adjunct – pear, watercress, endive and arugula salad, with chopped walnuts, a Meyer lemon truffle oil garlic dressing. Main thing here is use an old Christopher crushed garlic container as a cruet to mix the oil and squeezed lemon. Add pepper. Dollop of truffle oil, rest use walnut oil to avoid taste overdose.

Sabor of Spain, San Rafael. Here again, while Bubba loves Spain, especially Pamplona, it was all about the outdoor markets where they sell jam-bon, cow noses, blocks of Basque cheese the size of small car tires, and fresh bread and olive oil to bathe in. Nope, Sabor is not in that vein - Sabor has small little tapas that involve vegetables, baby artichokes, olives, tomatoes and peppers, anchoives and cool spicing. Grilled dates, empanada's, frittata, paella. Nice Temparrillo wine too (that's a red, of course. Bubba does not do white even with fish). Bro's do not do white.

The home adjunct – mushroom sauté. Saute garlic, organic mushroom mix of buttons, shitake, brown, etc, with a mix of fresh basil, sage, oregano, thyme and rosemary, use walnut oil, and at end, add small dollop white truffle oil, sear with quarter cup of red wine.

President's Message cont'd.

Jhan Thong, Thai, Northgate One

This family run endoit has great, soft, Zen decor, and a nice take out menu that is quick, and great brown-red jasmine rice that lasts a week for a base from home cooking stir fry's. Anything to avoid Quionah. Try the sautéed spinach salad, and vegetarian curry, with mushrooms that "taste like chicken."

The home adjunct – lemon grass stir fry. Use garlic, cut lemon grass stalks, fresh basil and cilantro, peppers, French green beans, fresh fennel bulb cut thin, spinach, along with ginger, fry in sesame and chile oil. If you wish add shitake mushrooms. Serve over brown rice. Add veggies in order of stoutness – the firmer the veggie, the earlier it gets fried. Spinach is last.

Tacqueria San Jose, San Rafael

This fancy bistro is located conveniently under Highway 101 at Fourth Street. It has full time Soccer in Spanish on TV. It has the best fish taco's in Marin, and Bubba knows fish taco's. Fresh and

cheap.

The home adjunct – Thai or Veracruz Halibut, grilled, over roasted chile torched pumpkin seeds. Bubba believes each dish should be from a different region, so mix and match. If you go Thai, lay a bed of lemon grass underneath your fish on the grill, and create a Thai paste – lemon grass, ginger and cilantro, with chile paste and lime juice, put on fish both sides, and grill. Use the little tubes of paste found in the refrigerated spice section of your local store. . Can substitute Salmon or Sea Bass. If using Ahi, add nothing. Place grilled fish on plate over pumpkin seeds lightly toasted in a frying pan, in crushed garlic, cumin seeds, and ground poblano chile spice that is deep brown red in color. If your forehead sweats over the pan, it's just right.

If you go Veracruz, use chipotle sauce, or a spice rub on the fish including cumin, cilantro, garlic, oregano, lime. Or, grill over an Anaheim.
